

REOPENING GUIDELINES:

We want this to be a HAPPY occasion for everyone. If you have to endure any minor inconveniences, please consider it a sacrifice that will allow you to make your friends, fellow members, and our valued employees more comfortable.

1. We wish to remind all members that this is a health issue, not a political one. We respect the safety of all of our members!
2. We must follow protocols set forth by MIOSHA regarding workers' safety and that is why we used their poster. The executive order does not apply to individuals, but the aerie as an employer is REQUIRED to insure our employees' safety. See the difference?
3. Wearing a mask inside is not a law for individuals, *that is true*. As an employer we can be fined and shut down if we don't protect our employees. We do have the right to refuse entry if you are not wearing a mask.
4. We will make exceptions on a case by case basis for those who have medical conditions that make wearing a mask dangerous.
5. We understand that everyone has their own opinions about wearing masks. Those of us who are in charge of leading the club are doing our best under the circumstances and with the information available to respect everyone and keep everyone safe.
6. We feel that the best way to protect people at our club is to have everyone wear masks upon entry, when ordering food and drinks, and when walking around. You do not need to wear a mask while you are sitting at your table.
7. We will have tables spread out and we will have hand sanitizer available.
8. We understand some of you are not comfortable with our decision to require masks and we understand if you do not want to come to the club during this time. #peoplehelpingpeople
