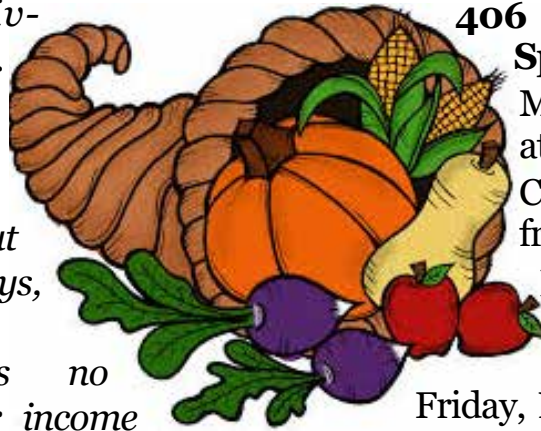


Community Thanksgiving Feast 2020
